Soccer Tryouts

Tryouts for Premier and Classic Girls & Boys Soccer Teams

The Madison Area Soccer Alliance (Madison 56ers, Magic, Regent, Shorewood, Middleton United and Verona Area Soccer Clubs) is designed to assist soccer players of every ability and interest level. Alliance clubs are comprised of more than 320 teams and 5,000 players, with many competitive teams at each age level. Through this cooperative system, every effort is made to ensure that every player with a Classic rating or higher is offered a place on a select team. Classic or above-rated players are offered spots on teams with: Madison 56ers (Regional League, State League) or Alliance (Classic) Teams. Players not receiving a Classic rating or better will be referred to their home club for placement on a recreational team. Alliance clubs work together to form "multi-club" teams to best fit players' needs. Team placement will be determined through a competitive, open tryout. Any player interested in select soccer is encouraged to attend regardless of club affiliation.

Tryout Process

- Held at Reddan Soccer Park on the dates listed below.
- Attend both days.
- Each session is 90 minutes; arrive at least 45 minutes before your session to check in and warm up
- Fees: \$ 30 if pre-registered on-line or postmarked 7 days before age group's tryout date. \$60 on site registration.
- Pre-registration is highly recommended.
- Madison 56ers and Alliance Classic tryouts are held at the same time.
- Fill out attached registration form, include fees made payable to the tryout club and send to the mailing address listed on the right.

- Madison 56ers teams close in age group will work together at times providing an opportunity for teams to train with and against each other and for players to be exposed to different coaches and coaching perspectives.
- By providing a unified club and program atmosphere at all age groups in the club young players are provided with a stable youth soccer experience as they grow through the club.
- The ability and quality of any soccer player can be assessed within 4 component areas: Technical Ability (ball skill), Tactical Awareness (decision making), Psychological Characteristics (good listener, ability to stay on task), Fitness and Athleticism.

The Madison 56ers are proud partners with the Magic, Middleton United, Regent, Shorewood, and Verona Area Soccer Clubs (The Alliance). While many of these clubs' players will come to the 56ers or Alliance competitive tryouts we invite players from all clubs to our tryouts. We have a strong Dane County presence with several players from outside the Madison community.

Reminders

Registration Checklist

- Signed registration form
- Check made payable to tryout club: \$ 30 if pre-registered on-line or post-marked 7 days before age group's tryout date. \$60 on site registration.
- Copy of birth certificate or passport only for U11 or if this is your first year playing at a classic or above level.
- Send applications to tryout club (addresses at right)

Tryout Day:

- Arrive 45 minutes early to check-in and warm up
- Players must wear shin guards and shoes (cleats preferred)
- Bring inflated soccer ball and water bottle
- Players receive tryout number and t-shirt (wear t-shirt both days)
- Attend parent meeting for appropriate club (56ers meeting is mandatory)
- Parent may not be on the tryout fields

Notification:

- All Alliance players will receive notification by e-mail or phone.
- Because tryouts take place during regular season play, offers at U12-U15 will be made no sooner than June 13. U11 notifications begins no sooner than June 13.
- Typically, the 56ers offers will be made first; Alliance team offers will be made either the same day as 56ers offers or one day following.
- You have 24 hours to accept an offer. After this time all offers are null and void.

Acceptance:

- Once you accept an offer, you must secure your roster spot with a non-refundable deposit to the appropriate soccer club. (See list at right for amount).
- Please write players name, age group (i.e. U12) and team name on the check.
- Deposits for the Madison 56ers must be dropped off at their office (see address at upper right).

Why do I need to submit a copy of my child's birth certificate every year?

Birth certificates are required by MAYSA to verify the player's age. Each competitive player is issued a player pass card that includes the player's photo, signature and age. Once a player's date of birth has been verified by MAYSA, birth certificates are not required for subsequent years.

What are the age group cutoff dates?

An age group year runs from August 1 through July 31. A U11 player for 2011-2012 must be born on or after August 1, 2000 or August 1, 2000 – July 31, 2001. The age cut-off dates can be found on the web at: wiyouthsoccer.com
